Cindy Butts, Chair of the Independent Commission for Equity in Cricket (ICEC) said:

"We want to thank the thousands of people who have contributed to the Commission's work.

"We have analysed trends from the online survey, which ran in winter 2021, and captured the lived experiences of 4125 people in cricket. Commissioners have met with over 70 individuals and organisations, collected over 550 documents from cricketing bodies and experts.

"We are absolutely certain we would not have developed our knowledge and understanding of what can be done to improve equity across the game without the tremendous contribution from the public, current and former players and cricketing organisations. As a Commission we have been humbled by the level of courage demonstrated by so many who want to help the game to be equitable, diverse and inclusive.

We are considering further critical evidence, analysing data and drafting conclusions. Our report will be published early in the new year."
